An Open Letter from the Businesses, Non-Profits, and Civic Leadership of Nevada County in Support of California's Public Health Mandate

You pull up to a 4 way stop in Nevada County, and no one moves because we all wave to each other to go first? Sound familiar? If so, then you have experienced the Nevada County way. We are the community that takes care of each other. Today, we need that community spirit more than ever.

Remember when we sheltered at home and everything was shut down? It was hard but we did it and Nevada County held at 41 cases for a month. Then, to prevent businesses from failing, and because our mental health from living in isolation was threatened, we started to re-open.

Today we are at 108 confirmed cases of COVID 19 and rising. We have people across the spectrum refusing to do what seems to be a much easier sacrifice than isolation; wearing a mask in public. Our businesses, elected officials and public health officers are facing threats. These are our community members doing their best to keep us safe. Our public health officials are educated in science and medicine. They are not politicians, they are public servants dedicated to public safety. More than ever our lives depend on being able to trust guidance from public health leaders and departments. When we silence or threaten those charged with safeguarding the public's health, we undermine our ability to stay as healthy as possible.

Who are we impacting by not following the guidelines? Maybe it's your 16 year old neighbor at their first grocery store job, being harassed while asking a customer to wear a mask. Maybe it's your aunt or nephew who has an auto-immune disease and is high risk. Maybe it's law enforcement, called over a mask dispute, instead of managing a far greater emergency like an accident or fire. Where will we be if we don't follow the guidelines, and cases continue to rise? Likely headed into another shutdown which would devastate our local economy even more.

At this moment in history, we will be remembered for our sacrifice and our ability to adapt while facing increasing financial instability, mental health challenges, and public health crises. We must ensure Nevada County remains strong. We must wear masks, practice social distancing, and wash our hands regularly. This is for the benefit of us all.

If you agree wearing a face covering in public and continuing social distancing is better than isolation and shutdown, please let your voice be heard. Attend virtual public meetings, write or speak to your supervisor or local elected, and share your support for enforcement of the mandate. Write a letter to the editor. Write or call your favorite stores and commend them or insist they enforce mask wearing. Share this letter with your networks. Do your part to keep Nevada County safe and resilient.





Supervisors,

First let me say that by not having an in person board meeting today you are betraying your oath to the citizens of this County who you were elected to serve. There is no "health" of "safety" rationale for it. Our County COVID-19 numbers continue to be almost negligible and are in fact far less dangerous than the seasonal flu. We have had 1 death during this "pandemic" in a county of 100,000 people. In the last year for which we have statistics (2017-2018) we had 30 flu related deaths. While I understand it was very uncomfortable to be forced to actually face your citizenry as you had to at the last board meeting, it does not excuse you hiding from them at this meeting. Supervisor Hall's embarrassing "leadership" and handling of public comments at the last meeting is a "you" problem, not a "we" problem. By not allowing for public comment today in person you are actually violating the law.

Regarding today's meeting and COVID-19 discussion item 40 I would like to pose the following questions to staff. These questions are predicated on the fact that they SHOULD be what determines whether our schools in this County open normally or with restrictions (see below for the options the schools face).

- 1. How many cases of COVID-19 have been recorded in the 4-18 year old population in Nevada County?
- 2. How many cases of student to student transmission of COVID-19 have been recorded?
- 3. How many cases of teacher/staff to student transmission have been recorded?
- 4. How many cases student to adult transmission have been recorded?

Here are the options schools have regarding re-opening. Assuming the responses to my above questions are what I believe them to be, anything other than a normal re-opening is cruelty and not backed by any science.

Tentative School Structure Models for the 2020-21 School Year

- **Full School.** We know how to serve our students. If we have no restrictions from state and local public health officials, we will move forward with full school as we know it.
- Full Distance Education. We know this is very far from ideal, but we also know that there is a potential we may find ourselves in this situation at some point during the school year as the virus runs its course. We will go to this model if the Nevada County Public Health Dept requires schools to shut down

- at any point during the school year. We are also prepared to accommodate families who may choose this as an option, regardless of our school status. We are working very hard to provide staff development and improve upon our practice of delivering instruction remotely. This will prepare us for this scenario, as well as the following model.
- Hybrid/Cohort Model. We have tentative plans in development that would allow us to adhere to the
 guidelines from the CA Dept of Public Health, and we are coordinating student attendance days with
 neighboring Nevada County districts. This model would involve two cohorts of students who alternate
 student attendance days. The model accommodates for physical distancing, adherence to sanitation
 practices, and all other required safety protocols and precautions.



Dear Board Members and Clerk,

According to the California Emergency Services Act (ESA) Section 8558-b: a state of emergency can only be called if the threat overwhelms the current resources of the state.

Furthermore, the state of emergency has to be terminated at the earliest possible date. Section 8558 (b) "State of emergency" means the duly proclaimed existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the state caused by such conditions as air pollution, fire, flood, storm, epidemic, riot, drought, sudden and severe energy shortage, plant or animal infestation or disease, the Governor's warning of an California Emergency Services Act 4 California Governor's Office of Emergency Services earthquake or volcanic prediction, or an earthquake, or other conditions, other than conditions resulting from a labor controversy or conditions causing a "state of war emergency," which, by reason of their magnitude, are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of any single county, city and county, or city and require the combined forces of a mutual aid region or regions to combat.

THUS: A state of emergency related to public health can only be declared if the threat overwhelms the response capabilities of California's health care practitioners

Thousands of healthcare workers are being furloughed in California, so there is zero evidence of grounds for this state of emergency based on public health.

There is no "threat that overwhelms the current resources of the state" since the covid-related deaths (with inflated numbers) are fewer than 3,000 in CA, compared to 6,000+ for the average seasonal flu.

Therefore, covid-19 cannot lawfully be classified as an "epidemic". An epidemic is when there are disproportionately large numbers experiencing an outbreak of a disease. There is no evidence of this in California.

Therefore, the basis for the State of Emergency is invalid and unlawful (see section 8558 b). As we have clearly seen here in California, with the virus fatalities, they are approximately 1/3 of the typical fatalities for a regular seasonal flu.

Therefore, our state resources are not overwhelmed.

Therefore the state of emergency should have been terminated according to California law, which states, at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant.

Therefore there are no legal grounds for an additional extension or a new state of emergency to be declared.

Thus, according to California law, the grounds for the state of emergency do not exist.

Therefore, the current state of emergency in California is invalid and unlawful.

Regarding the length of the state of emergency, the law is murky. For the declaration of local emergencies, a governing body is required to renew the state of emergency after 30 days. For a state-wide declaration of state of emergency, whereby the state is controlling the food and pharmaceuticals, the orders expire after 60 days. § 8627.5.

The temporary suspension of any statute, ordinance, regulation, or rule shall remain in effect until the order or regulation is rescinded by the Governor, the Governor proclaims the termination of the state of emergency, or for a period of 60 days, whichever occurs first.

(Section 8567(b): Whenever the state of war emergency or state of emergency has been terminated, the orders and regulations shall be of no further force or effect.

This means that all of the orders that were created under the State of Emergency are also expired, including but not limited to: stay at home order, social distancing, wearing of masks, closing of businesses and schools, etc.

Note: There are countless reports of other state's legislative bodies extending or denying their state of emergency declaration, but why nothing from California?

What evidence (as required by state law) have the health officers submitted to you that supports their orders?

I would like to know what the lawmakers are doing to address this invalid and unlawful state of emergency declaration. Please denounce the Governor's authority as he has grossly over stepped and has legal right to continue this state of emergency. Enough is enough!

"There is no threat of an epidemic that overwhelms the resources of the state, and therefore according to the Emergency Services Act, section 8558(b) there are no grounds for a State of Emergency in California."


