Funded with \$1.5M in Coronavirus Relief Funds (CRF)



Purpose

- Support entities that are critical to maintaining the County's economic and cultural infrastructure.
- These entities play a vital and enduring role in the local community.



Criteria

Request for Applications must adhere to CARES Act requirements and demonstrate:



1. Fiscal impacts of business interruption caused by COVID-19
2. Large and ongoing economic impact
3. Track record of leveraging additional partnerships and resources
4. Capacity to manage, oversee, implement and report on the use of the funds
5. Significant community benefit

Eligibility

- **Businesses**
 - **Nonprofits (501c3 and 501c6)**
 - **Local jurisdictions**
- **Grants will range from \$50,000 to \$500,000**
 - **At least 2-4 grants allocated in the \$300,000 to \$500,000 range.**



Application Timeline

- **Pre-Application Conference – 8/6**
- **Application Deadline – 8/20**
- **Evaluation – 8/21-27**
- **Interviews – 8/31 (if needed)**
- **NOI to Award – 9/4**
- **BOS Decision – 9/22**
- **Evaluation panel of 5-7 County staff and community partners**
- **Outreach**

 - Notice in The Union/Sierra Sun
 - Various email lists
