OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE RENEWAL STANDARD AGREEMENT NUMBER 20F-3029 WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT (CSD) FOR FUNDING OF 2020 COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT (CSBG) PROGRAMS TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT PAYABLE FROM \$308,870 TO \$311,667 (AN INCREASE OF \$2,797) (RES. 20-011 AND RES. 20-194)

WHEREAS, per Resolution 19-381, the Board approved the 2020/21 Nevada County Community Action Plan (CAP), which established a list of priorities for addressing and expending available CSBG funds to meet the needs of low-income residents; and

WHEREAS, per Resolution 20-011, the Board of Supervisors approved the Standard Agreement 20F-3029 to receive funding from the State Department of Community Services and Development's (CSD) Community Services Block Grant (CSBG), in the maximum amount of \$271,287 for the term of January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, and was subsequently amended on June 9 2020 per Resolution 20-194 to increase the maximum contract amount to \$308,870, replacing certain terms and conditions, and extending the term of the agreement to May 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the County is in receipt of Amendment No. 02 to the Agreement which increases maximum award amount to \$311,667.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that Amendment No. 2 to Agreement 20F-3029 by and between the County and the State Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) increasing the maximum amount payable from \$308,870 to \$311,667 (an increase of \$2,797), be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Amendment on behalf of the County of Nevada.

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

Dear Executive Director:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that on June 18, 2020, the Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) received additional Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).

The Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020 (H.R. 1865), authorized the HHS Secretary to withhold up to one percent of FY 2020 CSBG funding for discretionary projects. For FY 2020, HHS did not utilize the withheld funds and in accordance with H.R. 1865 will distribute the remaining funds to states. California's share of the one percent funding distribution is \$657,355, bringing the total 2020 CSBG final grant allocation to \$65,735,512.

Attached is CSBG Contract Amendment 2 for the term of January 1, 2020 through May 31, 2021. Due to the increased CSBG contract amount, all agencies must submit a revised CSD 425 CSBG Budget Series reflecting the amount identified on the 2020 CSBG Allocation Spreadsheet listed under the column labeled "Total 2020 Contract." A revised CSD 641 is optional if there are no changes to your current work plan.

The budget and work plan forms may be accessed through CSD's Providers' Website, located under the "Forms" tab after selecting "CSBG." Please refer to the contract checklist, which itemizes the contract deliverables that must be returned.

CSD looks forward to a continued productive partnership so that, together, we can effectively administer our critical programs and services designed to strengthen the economic security of vulnerable Californians.
