United Way's Local Impact in 2020

United Way of Nevada County currently has 19 partner organizations as part of our Partner Network. We collaborate with our partners to fill gaps in services. Through these collaborative efforts, we have formed three programs aimed at providing services to those in need.

1) United Way collaborated with California CareForce to bring the Free 2-day Health Clinic to Grass Valley in Jan. 2020. **850** patients were served over the two-day period. There are plans to bring the clinic back in 2022.



United Way's Local Impact in 2020

2) In 2017, United Way partnered with Interfaith Food Ministry (IFM) to form Food Access Saturday(FAS). Since the program was formed in 2017, **8500** bags of food were distributed to over **3700** individuals.

Food insecure individuals and families may get bags of nutritious food every second Saturday of the month.

Due to COVID-19, FAS has changed to a drive-thru food distribution.

3) Working with IFM and high school officials, the High School Food Pantry program was created in 2020 to make nutritious food available to students in crisis and their families. It began at Nevada Union, and now includes Bear River and Silver Springs.

Due to COVID-19, the distribution has become a drive-thru rather than the original pantry located at local high schools. So far hundreds of bags of food have been provided to those in need.
