NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, October 13, 2020, at 1:30 PM, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing to consider amendments to the Outdoor Event Ordinance (Article 2 of Chapter V of the General Code). The amendments include the following:

1) Increase the number of allowed events from four (4) to eight (8) per year; 2) Modify the permit issuing agency to the Community Development Agency from the Nevada County Sheriff's Office; 3) Provide clarification of sanitation requirements for portable toilets; 4) Remove the requirements for criminal record checks, and security posting; 5) Clarify the appeal and violation procedures; 6) remove residential zoning allowances; 7) prohibit events on three consecutive weekends.

The public meeting will be held at the Eric Rood Administration Center Board of Supervisor Chambers, located at 950 Maidu Avenue, Nevada City, following Governor Newsom's Executive Order pertaining to the COVID-19 pandemic and the social distancing guidelines as outlined by the Nevada County Public Health Department that remain in effect. The Board of Supervisors will return to the Board Chambers to attend the meeting and participate in person. The Board Chambers will remain closed to the public for seating during the meeting but will be open to the public for the purpose of receiving live public comment following social distancing guidelines.

Any person wishing to offer testimony on this matter may submit comments to the Clerk of the Board *in advance* of the meeting by:

2) Attending the public hearing at a kiosk located at the District V Board of Supervisors office in Eastern County (masks are required to enter County buildings);

3) Attending the public hearing inside the Eric Rood Administrative Center Board Chambers (masks are required to enter County buildings); or

4) Attending the public hearing by remote from the Eric Rood Administrative Center Board Chambers public comment kiosk located outside of the building (for individuals that are unable to wear a mask).

Please provide your name, City or District of residence, and reference the Outdoor Event Ordinance public hearing as your topic of interest.
