
RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES GRANT AWARD VW20340290 FOR THE NEVADA COUNTY VICTIM WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$292,323 FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2020 to SEPTEMBER 30, 2021

WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) has awarded the County of Nevada District Attorney's Office State Victim-Witness Assistance Grant Funds (VWA) and Federal Victim of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Cal OES grant award is comprised of State VWA funds in the amount of \$25,495 and Federal VOCA funds in the amount of \$267,583 for a total of \$292,323, and have been made available for the grant period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to provide services to victims and witnesses of crime as specified in the California Penal Code Sections 13835-13835.5, including crisis intervention and other comprehensive services for all victims and witnesses of crime.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, accepts the California Office of Emergency Services grant for Victim/Witness Assistance Program in the amount of \$292,323, for the grant period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021, for the Nevada County Victim Witness Assistance Program, which shall be deposited into District Attorney Revenue Account 0101 50608 203 1000 444890/446700.
