**SUBJECT:** Resolution authorizing execution of renewal Agreement No. 20-0172 with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) for Fiscal Years 2020/21 and 2021/22 for County Pest Detection/Emergency Projects Trapping services. Total contract amount not to exceed \$65,732.00 for the period July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2022.

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**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the Resolution.

**FUNDING:** Funding is for Fiscal Years 2020/21 and 2021/22 and is revenue from the CDFA for the Agricultural Commissioner budget. These funds are budgeted and there is no impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** The Agricultural Commissioner has contracted with CDFA for placing and servicing traps for the detection of exotic pests, which are considered hazardous to agriculture and the economy of California. Those inspections may include, but are not limited to, Mediterranean Fruit Fly, Mexican Fruit Fly, Oriental Fruit Fly, Melon Fly, Gypsy Moth, Japanese Beetle and other invasive exotic pests. The Agreement includes delimitation work associated with the detection of one or more life stages of the above target pests in the County. The State provides all traps, trap parts and lures, in addition to technical assistance and training for County staff.
