

## RESOLUTION No.96-33

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 69-102 ESTABLISHING A NEVADA COUNTY HISTORICAL LANDMARKS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Historical Landmarks Commission was established by Resolution 69-102; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of the Board of Supervisors to have the Nevada County Historical Landmarks Commission designate historical landmarks and take whatever steps are necessary to preserve same; and

WHEREAS, it is the Board of Supervisors' desire to reaffirm the duties and responsibilities of the Commission and to clarify Commission membership and appointment procedures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors the duties and responsibilities of the Nevada County Historical Landmarks Commission shall be as follows:

- 1. The Historical Landmarks Commission shall prepare an application form for registration of all proposed historical landmarks in Nevada County.
- 2. The Commission shall establish procedures for the submittal and verification of all proposed historical landmarks.
- 3. The Commission shall present all proposed historical landmarks to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Commission shall be comprised of ten (10) members, two to be appointed by each County Supervisor from the register of voters in his or her district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, members of the Commission shall be charged with carrying out the duties and responsibilities of the Commission and will serve at the will and pleasure of the appointing member of the Board of Supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Resolutions 71-293 and 92-363 are hereby rescinded.
