OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FUNDING AWARD FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, HOUSING AND DISABILITY ADVOCACY PROGRAM (HDAP) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 20/21 TO BE USED FOR THE NEVADA COUNTY SOARWORKS PROGRAM, UPON ACCEPTANCE THROUGH JUNE 30, 2021

WHEREAS, Housing and Disability Advocacy Program (HDAP) funding is available through the California Department of Social Services (CDSS), authorized per Assembly Bill (AB) 1603 (Chapter 25, Statutes of 2016); and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Social Services Department applied and was approved for HDAP funding in the amount of \$150,000 which requires a 100% County match contribution; and

WHEREAS, the remaining HDAP balance from Fiscal Year 2017/18 and 2019/20 of a combined \$150,981, previously accepted per Resolutions 20-164, 18-167 and 18-093, will also be used, bringing the total Fiscal Year 2020/21 amount available to \$300,981; and

WHEREAS, the funded HDAP allocation will be used to support ongoing operations and integration of SOARWorks, a program that will provide specialized case management and advocacy to individuals experiencing homelessness who may be eligible for social security or disability benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Fiscal Year 2020/21 Housing and Disability Advocacy Program funding award in the amount of \$150,000, to be used to support operations and integration of SOARWorks Program into the County's Continuum of Care (CoC) and requiring a 100% County match, is hereby accepted and available for use through June 30, 2021.

Funds to be deposited into revenue account: 1589-50105-494-1000/440450.
