



RESOLUTION No. 21-025

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING CONTINUATION OF SERVICES FOR GREAT PLATES DELIVERED PROGRAM BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND VARIOUS VENDORS, FOR FOOD SERVICE SUPPORT TO OUR SENIOR COMMUNITY IMPACTED BY COVID-19 IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,256,000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2021 OR AS EXPIRED BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Great Plates Delivered Program (Program) was approved by Governor Gavin Newsom on April 24, 2020, in response to the COVID pandemic as a short term support system designed to support adults 65 and older and adults 60-64 who are at high-risk from COVID-19, in staying home and staying healthy by delivering three (3) nutritious meals a day, and also provide essential economic stimulus to local businesses and workers struggling to stay afloat during the COVID crisis; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Program is funded through federal and state disaster relief reimbursement programs with a small local county match requirement; and

WHEREAS, the County elected to participate in the Program, providing nearly 35,604 meals to residents not otherwise eligible for federal or state supported nutrition services; and

WHEREAS, the State established the Program as a short-term solution which has since been extended in 30-day increments since May 2020, is expected to continue to be extended due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to continue the Great Plates Program providing meals to eligible high-risk residents and stimulate the local economy by supporting the local food vendors participating in the Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California:

1. Approves and the Board Chair is authorizing the continuation of Professional Services Contract for Great Plates- Food Service Support for our Senior Community impacted by COVID-19 on behalf of Nevada County with Emily's Cakes & Catering of Grass Valley, CA; Fudenjuce of Nevada City, CA; and Kalizsu LLC dba Osorio Kitchen of Grass Valley, CA, through June 30, 2021 or until the State discontinues support of this Program in the maximum amount not to exceed \$1,256,000.
2. Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to encumber the contracts and to make change orders to these contracts as needed up to the approved amount as may be necessary to continue to support this Program in alignment with State directive and to meet the needs of the County.

3. The Auditor-Controller is directed to release \$31,000 from the General Fund Available Fund Balance and amend the Department of Social Services budget for Fiscal Year 2020/21 as follows:
