**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving a Standard Public Works Contract between the

County of Nevada and Bockmon & Woody Electric Co., Inc., for the

Nevada County Eric Rood Administrative Center Generator

Replacement Project in the amount of \$435,000 plus a contingency of \$43,500 for a total contract amount of \$478,500, authorizing the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the contract, and amending the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Capital Facilities Budget (4/5 Affirmative Vote

Required).

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the Resolution

<u>FUNDING</u>: This project will be paid out of the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Capital Facilities budget and partially funded through a onetime grant that was received by the Office of Emergency Services to help mitigate the impact of the Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) in FY 19/20 in the amount of \$375,514. To date we have spent \$12,600 for the plans and engineering in support of the generator for the Eric Rood Administrative Center (ERAC). The generator purchase utilized \$178,047 of the available funding. The remaining \$184,867 of the PSPS grant and PG&E Settlement funds will be used for the installation services, underground electrical wiring, and PG&E site work. A budget amendment is included.

**BACKGROUND:** By previous action of the Board, Resolution 21-082 authorized the Purchasing Agent to solicit bids for the project known as the Nevada County Eric Rood Administrative Center Generator Replacement. An Invitation to Bid was sent to builders' exchanges, local contractors were notified, and a Public Notice advertisement was posted in the local newspaper. One (1) bid was received from Bockmon & Woody Electric Co., Inc., of Stockton, California, in the amount of \$435,000. An abstract of the bid results is attached.

The contract will be in the bid amount of \$435,000 and a 10% contingency of \$43,500 will be added to the encumbrance for a total encumbered amount of \$478,500.
