SUBJECT:Resolution to Award the Contract for the 2021 Road Rehabilitation<br/>Project to Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc., for a Total Amount of<br/>\$833,532.70 and Renumber the County Project Number from<br/>426638 to 450008 - District I, II, III, IV

**<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**: Approve the attached Resolution to award the contract for the 2021 Road Rehabilitation Project to Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc., in the total amount of \$833,532.70.

**<u>FUNDING</u>**: Project will be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds, there is no impact to the General Fund. The project is funded by Road Engineering SBU 30104 and there is sufficient budget in the FY 2020-21 budget; no budget amendment is necessary.

**BACKGROUND:** On February 23, 2021, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 21-037 that approved the bidding documents for the subject project and instructed the Nevada County Purchasing Division to advertise for bids. The bids were opened on March 25, 2021, and are listed below:

\*There was one minor bid irregularity on the B&M Builders bid which did not affect the outcome of the award.

It is recommended that the contract be awarded to the low bidder, Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc., at the bid price of \$757,757.00, plus a 10% contingency of \$75,775.70 for a total of \$ \$833,532.70. Work is expected to begin in July 2021 and be completed by Fall 2021.
