Please consider my application for appointment as Nevada County District Attorney.

My experience makes me a uniquely qualified candidate for this position. I have been a prosecutor for the past fifteen years. The past four-years I have served in a management role as Assistant District Attorney here in Nevada County. I worked previously in Kings, Fresno, and Santa Clara County, and have excelled in each office. In my career I have been assigned to specialty units that focused on criminal street gangs, sexual assault, and homicide. I have tried many high-profile and complex cases; including a cold case, rape-murder committed in 1983. I was twice recognized as the Prosecutor of the Year in Fresno County and was nominated for Trial Attorney of the year in Santa Clara County.

Importantly, I am grounded in this community. Over the past years Nevada County went from being a beautiful place where I wanted to live to becoming my home. My kids go to school here and are involved in sports. I own a house on Banner Mountain and a cabin in Truckee. I have developed strong connections with local law enforcement, community leaders, and civic groups.

I have the support of my boss, District Attorney Cliff Newell. I have included his most recent evaluation of me as a part of this application. We have a great team and it would be an honor to lead them moving forward.
