Utilizing the data obtained in completing the CFMP, Facilities categorizes and prioritizes various Capital Projects.

The following is an example of some of the source data used in this analysis:

- Facilities Assessments (Deferred Maintenance)
- ADA Surveys (Accessibility & Safety)
- County-wide Plans (Energy Action Plan)

OUR PROCESS RELATED TO THE COMPLETED FACILITIES MASTER PLAN:

- 1. Analyze facilities ADA and condition data to categorize projects:
- ADA/Safety
- Deferred Maintenance
- Department Requested
- 2. Prioritize and program to a five-year project schedule:
- Health and Safety factors
- Project Management Capacity
- Funding
- 3. Present projects to the Capital Facilities Subcommittee





CAPITAL PROJECTS 2020 - 2025

Facilities Management estimates a \$5.9 million dollar expenditure on Capital Projects over the next five years.

- 30% ADA / Safety
- 37% Deferred Maintenance
- 33% Department Requests





FACILITIES MASTER PLAN GOING FORWARD

- Five-year Capital Project list has been developed consisting of projects within the three categories.
- Facilities will continue to update and add projects to the five-year Capital Project list each fiscal year.
- Facilities will update the Plan to present to the Board in five years (2025-2026).
