SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY FOR \$11,400.00 IN FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE LUNCH AT THE LIBRARY PROGRAM AT THE NEVADA COUNTY COMMUNITY LIBRARY FOR USE DURING THE PERIOD JUNE 7, 2021 TO SEPTEMBER 3, 2021 FOR SUMMER LUNCH PROGRAMS, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY LIBRARIAN TO SIGN ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THIS GRANT AND DIRECTING THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 LIBRARY BUDGET. (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

FUNDING: FY21/22 grant of \$11,400.00 requiring acceptance from the Board of Supervisors. Funding source is from the California State Library. There is no impact on the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: In 2018 and 2019, The California State Library awarded funds to the Nevada County Community Library to support the Lunch at the Library program in Grass Valley in conjunction with the Grass Valley School District Child Nutrition Services. This program successfully provided meals and programs to youth in the community. This year the State Library is again providing funding to host a program in Grass Valley and the Town of Truckee. In addition to providing meals, library staff provide programs, which encourage physical activity and literacy skill building and provide stipends for teen interns assisting with the program.
