

RESOLUTION No. 21-403

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR CIVIL COMMITMENT PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE SEXUALLY VIOLENT PREDATORS ACT, WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTIONS 6600 THROUGH 6609.3

WHEREAS, Welfare and Institutions Code was amended to allow certain inmates to be committed to the Department of State Hospitals at the conclusion of their prison term, known as the Sexually Violent Predators Act (SVPA), (Welfare and Institutions Code sections 6600 through 6609.3); and

WHEREAS, the Sexually Violent Predators Act requires that each county board of supervisors designate either the County Counsel or the District Attorney to assume responsibility for the civil commitment proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that the District Attorney is the appropriate official to review and litigate such petitions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, does hereby designate the Nevada County District Attorney to assume responsibility for civil commitment proceedings pursuant to the Sexually Violent Predators Act.
