SUBJECT: Resolution accepting the California Office of Emergency

Services Grant Award VW21350290 for the Nevada County

Victim Witness Assistance Program in the amount of \$289,251.00 for the period of October 1, 2021 through

September 30, 2022, and authorizing the District Attorney, or their assignee, to execute the grant agreement and all additional

documents to fulfill the grant requirements

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the Resolution accepting the grant award.

FUNDING:

The California Office of Emergency Services provides State Victim Witness Assistance Funds (VWAO), State Victim of Crimes General Funds (VCGF), and Federal Victim of Crime Act (VOCA) funds to all California counties. The funding cycle runs on the Federal calendar year from October thru September. There is no impact on the General Fund.

BACKGROUND:

The Victim Witness Program provides comprehensive services as specified in California Penal Code sections 13835-13835.5 to victims and witnesses of crime. State VWAO funds in the amount of \$24,741, State VCGF funds in the amount of \$155,158 and Federal VOCA funds in the amount of \$109,352, have been awarded to the Nevada County Victim Witness Program for a total of \$289,251, for the grant period of October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022.

This grant funding will support immediate crisis intervention and other comprehensive services for all victims and witnesses of crime whether the crime occurred in Nevada County or the victim or witness was a resident of Nevada County at the time they were harmed by a criminal act. The program strives for complete restoration of the victim's dignity, health and resources.
