SUBJECT:	Resolution accepting the 2021 Community Policing Development Crisis Intervention Teams Grant from the Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services in the amount of \$250,000 to fund the salary and benefits of a trained Crisis Clinician for a second Mobile Crisis Team over a two year period commencing November 1, 2021, and authorizing the Sheriff to electronically accept the award and sign the award documents and directing the Auditor-Controller to amend the Sheriff's Office and Behavioral Health FY 21/22 budget (4/5 affirmative vote required)

### **<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**: Adopt Resolution

**FUNDING:** Funding from the Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services in the amount of \$125,000 for FY 21/22 and \$125,000 for FY 22/23 for a total of \$250,000 impacts the Sheriff's Office Operation's Budget as well as the Behavioral Health Operating Budget. A budget amendment for FY 21/22 is needed (4/5 affirmative vote needed).

**BACKGROUND:** The Sheriff's Office has received notice that the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services Grant has awarded \$250,000 to the County to be expended over an approximate two year period, \$125,000 for FY 21/22 and \$125,000 for FY 22/23.

This grant is to be used to pay for the salary and benefits of a trained crisis clinician for a second Mobile Crisis Team. The clinician is to be hired through Nevada County Behavioral Health via a contract with Sierra Mental Wellness Group as a subrecipient of the grant. Project Management for this Program will be jointly overseen by Nevada County Behavioral Health and Nevada County Sheriff's Office. Any salary/benefit costs exceeding the grant amount are to be provided by Nevada County. The revenue and expense were not budgeted for FY 21/22, so an accompanying budget

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amendment is requested for FY 21/22. Grant funding and costs for FY 22/23 will be included in the 22/23 fiscal year budgets.
