## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

## RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION (SAMHSA) FOR THE COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH CENTERS (CMHC) GRANT TO INCREASE PEER SUPPORT STAFFING WITHIN THE COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SYSTEM FROM SEPTEMBER 30, 2021 TO SEPTEMBER 29, 2023 IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000

WHEREAS, a SAMHSA (Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration) Community Mental Health Centers (CMHC) Grant is available to the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the CMHC program is to enable community mental health centers to support and restore the delivery of clinical services that were impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and effectively address the needs of individuals with serious emotional disturbance (SED), serious mental illness (SMI), and individuals with SMI or SED and substance use disorders, referred to as co-occurring disorder (COD); and

WHERAS, the monies awarded to Nevada County will be utilized to expand the use of peers within the behavioral health workforce and to expand clinical and case management capacity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby accepts the grant funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Community Mental Health Centers (CMHC) grant for the period of September 30, 2021 through September 29, 2023.
